## White Wines

1. **Arena Negra Sauvignon Blanc 2015 (Chile)** £14.95  
*Pale straw yellow in colour. The nose is full of citrus, herbs and passion fruit. The palate is crisp, lemon-scented and medium-full bodied, with a touch of florality alongside the appealing, juicy fruit flavours.*
2. **Arena Negra Chardonnay 2014 (Chile)** £14.95  
*Classic tropical fruit style chardonnay with mineral notes and is unoaked. Hints of citrus fruit and melons in this lovely well made Chardonnay.*
3. **Borgo Selene Blanco Sicilia 2014 (Italy)** £15.95  
*Light, lemon-yellow in colour with a fresh, vivacious nose, clean, fresh perfumes of apples and ripe pears with a hint of acacia flower. Crisp and lively on the palate with a dry, lightly perfumed finish.*
4. **Pulenta Estate Pinot Gris 2014 (Argentina)** £21.95  
*The palate has all the viscosity and texture that one so often relishes in the best examples from this variety, with plenty of richness, but fine definition born out of both the impressive altitude of the vineyard and the careful winemaking flowers, fruit and a hint of natural sweetness complete the picture.*
5. **Tinpot Hut Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2015 (New Zealand)** £27.95  
*Intense aromas of blackcurrant, crushed lemongrass and thyme mingle with passion fruit and melon highlights. Underlying ripe fruit and mineral notes from the grapes grown in the Blind River sub-region of Marlborough combine well with the more tropical notes from the Wairau Valley vineyards. Stylish and pleasantly rich with a fine balance of acidity leading to a lingering finish.*
7. **Domaine Des Brosses Sancerre 2014 (France)** £29.95  
*Pale yellow in colour. The nose is fresh and full of hay, citrus and mineral notes. The palate is medium in body with crisp lemon acidity and an appealing creamy complexity alongside the ripe peach, elderflower and mineral flavours which last well on the long finish.*

## Rose Wines

8. **Alpha Zeta Rosato 2014 (Italy)** £15.95  
*Lovely light cherry pink in colour with a fresh perfume of cherry blossom and wild strawberries. Lively and fresh on the palate, with a juicy, cherry jam fruit character and a lifted, fragrant finish.*

## Red Wines

9. **Arena Negra Merlot 2015 (Chile)** £14.95  
*This wine has a vibrant colour, a soft, plummy nose which follows through to a relatively full-bodied palate, with rounded, tannins and a good finish.*
10. **Arena Negra Cabernet Sauvignon 2014 (Chile)** £14.95  
*Full bodied ripe and juicy, a hint of eucalyptus and a whole load of blackcurrant fruit, layered with savouriness that balances out the wine delightfully.*



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11. ***Borgo Selene Rosso Sicilia 2014 (Italy)*** £15.95  
*Ruby red in colour with an attractive perfume of fresh, ripe red berries and a hint of spice. Round and smooth on the palate, with sufficient body and soft tannins to support the juicy, blackberry and ripe, dark plum fruit character. Lovely spicy plum perfumes on the finish.*
12. ***Los Prados Cabernet/Malbec 2014 (Argentina)*** £17.95  
*Good depth of colour and attractive dark berry fruit on the nose. On the palate the wine is full-bodied while still retaining a youthful freshness. The Malbec adds a liquorice and tobacco character to the forward, cassis style of the Cabernet; this combined with a short spell in oak gives the wine a lovely finish.*
13. ***Navajas Rioja 2014 (Spain)*** £18.95  
*This is Rioja at its youthful best, with intense raspberry and black cherry fruit overlaid with a flourish of vanilla and coconut. It is beautifully balanced with medium weight and cushioned by fine grain tannins.*
14. ***Baglio Gibellina U Passimienta 2014 (Italy)*** £19.95  
*This wine is made from partially dried grapes, it has bright intense red fruit on the nose displaying lots of red berries. The palate is warm and full-bodied with sweet fruit and harmonious acidity and smooth and elegant tannins and bags of flavour.*
15. ***Les Hauts de Perganson Bordeaux 2012 (France)*** £28.95  
*The was an excellent vintage and the resulting wine is lush and ripe with aromas of blackberries and cassis. The tannins are very velvety with excellent balance and this wine is delicious to drink now.*
16. ***Veuve Chapelle n.v. (France)*** £19.95  
*Made in the Loire Valley, a clean, lively, fresh sparkling wine with grassy/almond notes on the finish. Surprisingly long finish and great for all occasions..*
17. ***Champagne Ayala Brut Majeur n.v (France)*** £37.95  
*Now part of the house of Bollinger. Aromatic and balanced, this shows great finesse and complexity. It is the Pinot Noir that gives the wine richness and a long finish while the Chardonnay adds delicacy, liveliness and freshness. Pinot Meunier gives the wine an appealing fruitiness and roundness.*
18. ***Champagne Bollinger Brut n.v (France)*** £54.95  
*Bollinger is made from first-run juice only, and the majority of vineyards used have Premier and Grand Cru status, resulting in a full-bodied Champagne of great class. Delightful pale gold in colour, the mousse is light and persistent. Classy stuff.*
19. ***Champagne Pol Roger n.v (France)*** £59.95  
*The small, classic bubbles, perfumed spice leading to a fruit filled bundle of vibrant tastes finishing with elegant spices and a hint of butter. On the nose, green apple, brioche and a trace of minerality dominates. On the palate there stone fruits, and a hint of honey supporting the freshness of the acidity.*

**Sparkling Wines**
